- Will international students who are off-shore be included in SES scope?
- How will changes in academic calendars impact on the sample and timing of the SES? What submission dates should be in scope for SES?
- Is August still suitable for the SES? September for trimesters? Are there institutions this doesn't suit?
- Is the HEIMS definition for study mode (external/internal) accurate or nuanced enough?
- How are survey managers interfacing with stats and data areas around 2020 SES sample in the world of TCSI changes to HEIMS submission dates?
- Are there going to be additional international student items in the main SES?
- What extra information do we need to best analyse QILT SES results or additional items we should ask about in 2020?
- How will we benchmark performance in relation to COVID-19 mitigation strategies? What is important to measure? How do we integrate this into normal institutional practice?
