



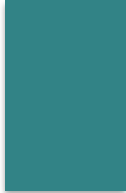

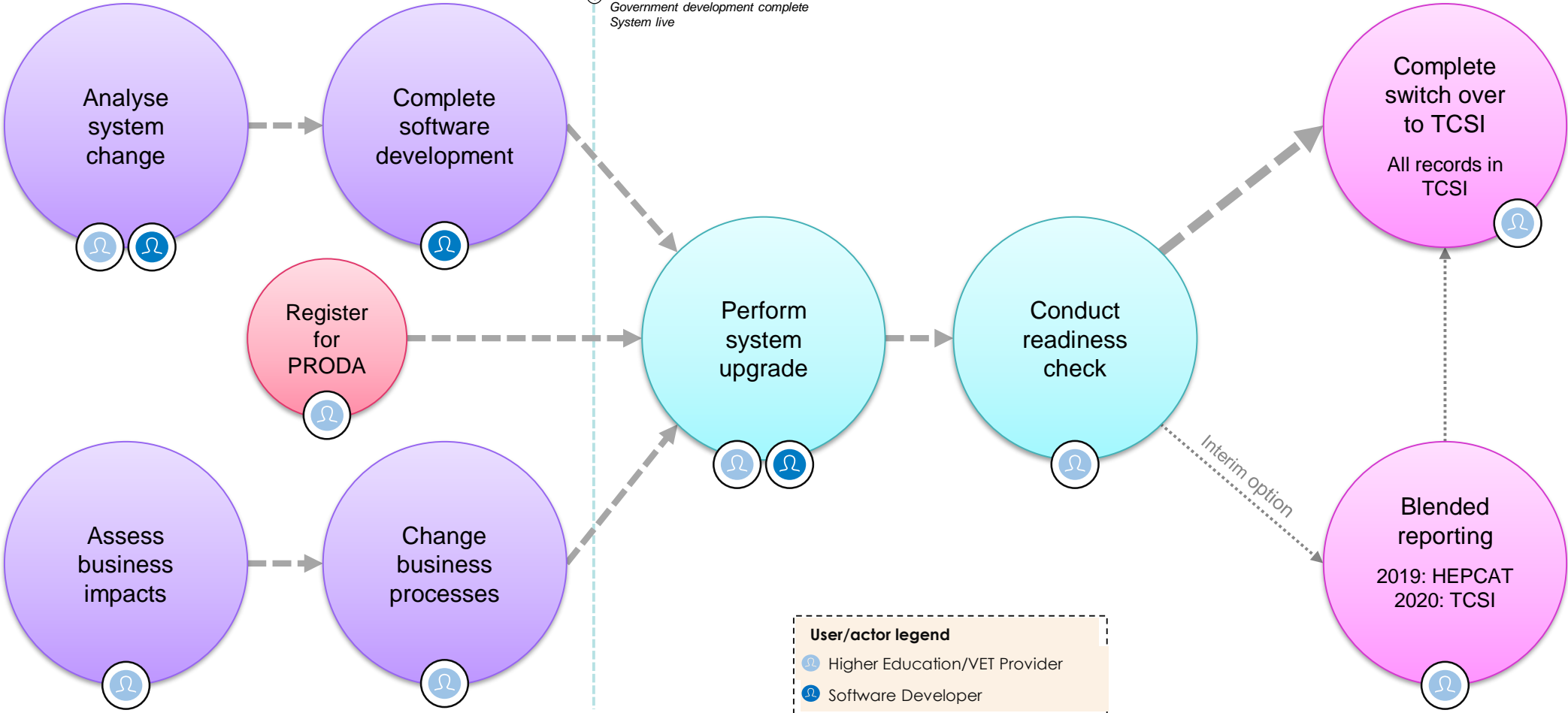

Courses of study, courses, campuses, students, course admissions, units of study, unit enrolments

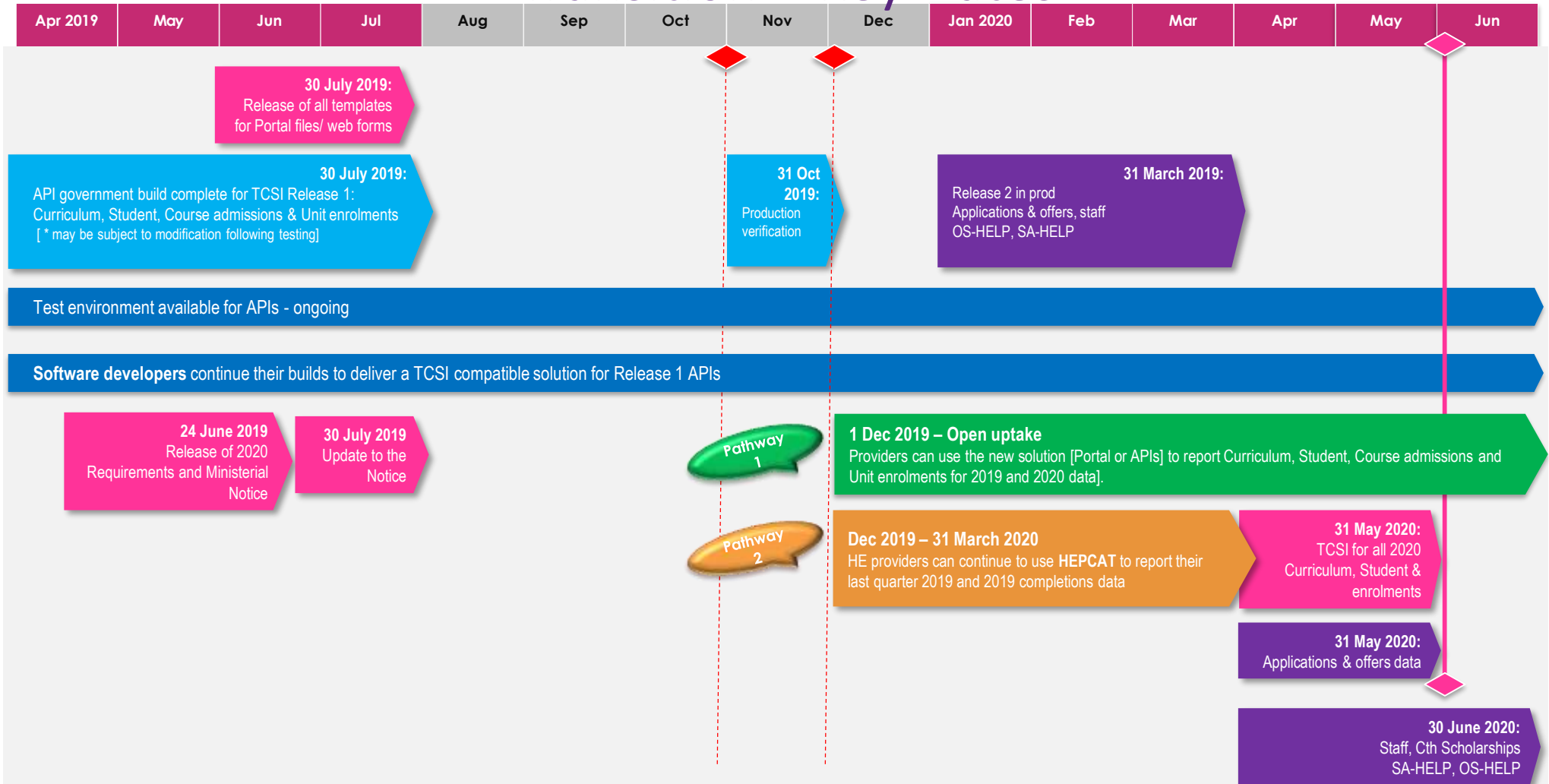
Available to test from mid-July 2019

OS-HELP, SA-HELP, Staff, applications, preferences, and offers.



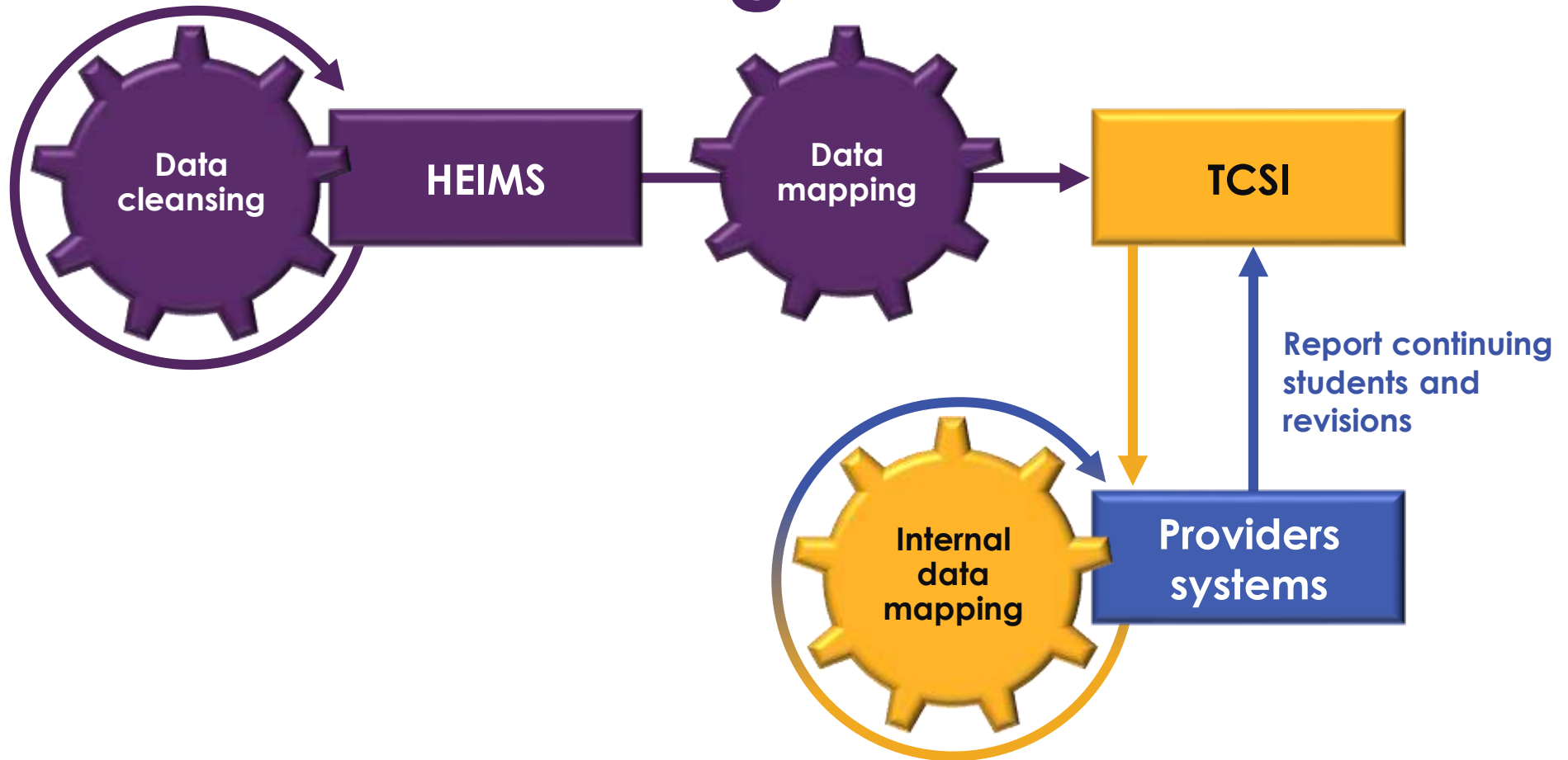

Completions

Changes to E599



- We need to maintain consistency in the statistical reporting
- We want to accommodate diverse sector practices where we can
- We want to reduce manual processing as much as we can
- We think we can meet most wants and needs by adding some new codes to E599 – course outcome code

Changes to E599



The basic idea is ...

- Report the completion in the way that best fits your practice, and
- Use E599 to tell us what is going on so we know how to treat the data for statistical purposes

Changes to E599

'completing' codes

Old E599:

- Only had one completion code: '1' completed
- Only report completion if it meets scope
- EG. Student in BA/LLB. Only report completion when all of BA/LLB is completed.

New E599 has two 'completing' codes:

- '1' = final completion... to report completion of BA/LLB
- '5' = component completion...provider *may* use this to report BA and/or LLB where student is also going to complete a BA/LLB
- Can report as many 'component completions' (5) as you want. Only one 'final completion' per enrolment to meet statistical needs.

Changes to E599

'Leaving the course' codes

Old E599:

- Only had one withdrawn code: '2'.

New E599 has three 'leaving the course' codes:

- '2' = withdrawal = leaving with no completion and no further study
- '6' = transfer to complete = leaving to complete related course
EG. Student starts BEc but leaves study early with a DipEc.
- '7' = transfer to continue = leaving course but continue a related course. EG. Student starts a BEc but transfers to continue study in a BEc/LLB.



PRODA

PRODA – Phase 1, 2 and 3

July 1 – July 31

Phase 1: Get Ready

- Identify key contacts
- Identify key information
- Create an individual PRODA account
- Think about your operating model/reporting structure

August 1 Onwards

Phase 2: Register

- Register your organisation in PRODA
- Create and add delegates and personnel

Late October Onwards

Phase 3: Complete

- Finalise your PRODA set-up

2020 HE Scope, Structure and Timing Document

Key Updates



Check out the
2020 requirements

- We have simplified the scope, structure and timing documents and consolidated these into a single document for higher ed.
- This includes simplifying “Mandatory minimum” and ‘required’. We now just specify the timeframe in which each element is required.
- Student names are now required sooner for students who are Commonwealth assisted
